



SOCIETY INFORMATION 2018

Please contact us if you have a requirement that is not covered by these guidelines and we will do our best to accommodate you.

Pyecombe is pleased to welcome society golfers for bookings of 10 or more on any weekday. Availability for your preferred date can be checked by contacting the office at Pyecombe.

Societies are welcome to play 18, 27 or 36 holes.

Societies may reserve tee times from 9.15 am on Monday, Thursday and Friday, 12 noon on Tuesday and 11am on Wednesdays.

We encourage society visitors to play in groups of 3, although we recognise that on occasions this is impractical or undesirable.

Payment is required prior to commencing play. Cheques should be made payable to Pyecombe Golf Club and/or Credit Card facilities are available.

The booking reservation form covers standard society arrangements. If you have any special requests, please speak with a member of the office staff who will endeavour to cater for your requirements. An email is sent one week before the reservation as a reminder to confirm approximate numbers and catering requirements. Final numbers are required 48 hours before the event.

Society members will become a temporary member of the Club for the day and will be required to complete a registration card prior to their round of golf. We ask you to abide by all Club Rules.

Etiquette. The over-riding requirement is for visitors to be dressed in smart and acceptable attire. Visitors are requested to refrain from wearing jeans, non-tailored shorts and non-golfing shirts on the golf course and jeans, trainers, wet golf gear, outside clothing, caps or golf shoes in the clubhouse.

Players play at their own risk and must be conscious of their own safety, and that of others, at all times. Care must be taken when playing adjacent to the South Downs Way, and players must ensure that any likely landing area is clear and it is safe to play.

We encourage all players at Pyecombe to play ready golf and to complete their round in good time. When a hole has been completed, players should leave the green immediately before marking scorecards.

Players must avoid taking trolleys onto any closely mown area. Please repair divots, pitch marks and rake bunkers.

Pyecombe Golf Club, working with you, will endeavour to make your visit to us as enjoyable as possible.
